Micah Distinguished Alumni Award

Saint John's Literary Institution handed out its inaugural Micah Distinguished Alumni Award at this year's graduation ceremonies held at St. Katharine Drexel Church on May 26, 2006. This year's inaugural recipient was Saint John's class of 1954 alumni, William J. Mohan.

Bill Mohan distinguished himself as a student while at Saint John's with his involvement as class secretary, student council representative, teen club member, class sergeant-at-arms, dance club committee member, inheritance business editor, and civil air patrol.

After graduating from Saint John's, Bill served the country as a member of the United States Army and he has had a long and distinguished career in the General Accounting Office.

Bill has unselfishly dedicated his life to Catholic education. He was a founding member of the Friends of Catholic Education Board of Directors, received the Friends of Catholic Education McElroy Award in 2004, and, today, serves as a member on the Board of Directors at the Visitation Academy. He has also faithfully served Saint John's as an unofficial historian, member of the Board of Directors, president of the Board of Directors, and as president of the Saint John's Alumni Association.

I write this on the last day of school. The year has gone by very quickly and has been very fruitful.

We have concluded two major job searches recently. Mr. Bob Boyer, our Interim Principal, is retiring this year. To fill the position for the school's principal, we conducted a national search. I am pleased to announce that Mr. Christopher Cosentino has accepted the position starting July 1st. Mr. Cosentino comes to us from St. Michael's Catholic Academy in Austin, Texas where he was the principal. Prior to that, he was the Dean of Students at St. Joseph's Prep in Philadelphia, principal at Our Mother of Consolation School in Philadelphia, and he was the Director of Athletics at Bishop Eustace Prep in Pennsauken, New Jersey. Mr. Cosentino brings a wealth of experience to the position and a high energy level and we are very excited that

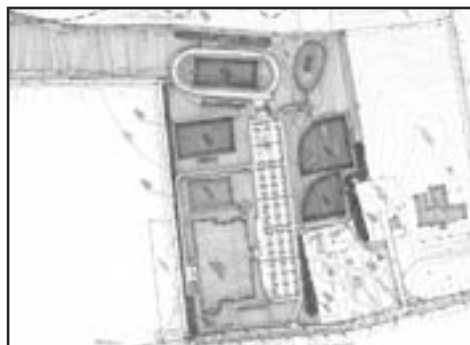
he is joining the Saint John's community. He and his family will be moving into the area at the end of June.

In April, Mr. Rich Fairley resigned as the Athletic Director and Boy's Varsity Basketball Coach. We were very fortunate in hiring Mr. Silas Cheung as the AD and Boy's Varsity Basketball Coach. He played his collegiate ball at Mount Saint Mary's and comes to us directly from Urbana High School. We also hired Mr. Phil

Martin as the Assistant AD and Football and Baseball Coach. Phil brings with him over 30 years of coaching experience at the collegiate level at Montgomery College and Shenandoah University.

By the time that you receive "The Legacy," we will have hired an architectural firm to design the new campus. Everything related to the move is on schedule and we are still aiming for a Fall 2008 opening. The architects will work with us to develop the plans for the new building as well as everything else that will be part of the new campus.

It has been a wonderful first year. Many changes have occurred to better position Saint John's for the future. I feel blessed to have been given the opportunity to serve the school as President and I very much look forward to next year where all of our plans will be further solidified.

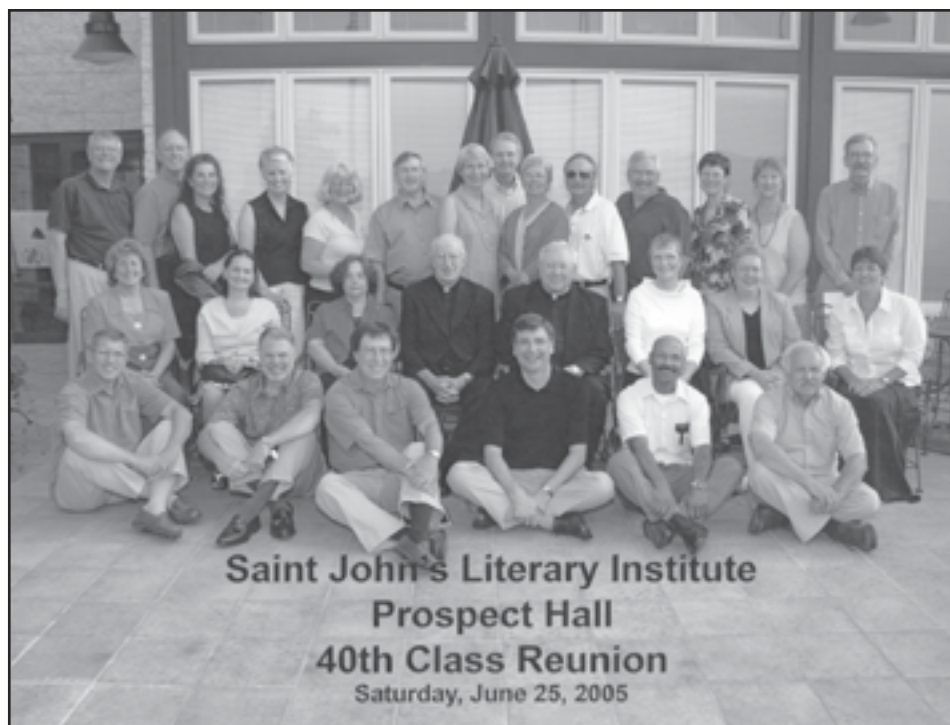
