

Online Assessments - Quia, Kahoot, and Quizlet

Quia

Go to <https://www.quia.com/web> and if prompted, the SJCP username is **sballantine**

And the password is **beach1**

Go to **Quizzes** and you will see all SJCP classes with their quizzes. Open one folder to see.

Go to **Shared activities** and search for your discipline and topic. There are many available activities which are probably already what you want to make. You can copy them and amend them for your use.

You can create classes where all of your students have to log-in to take the quizzes and you can limit the time frame of the document, the availability (1 trial or 2 or unlimited), the day it is available, all of that.

You can also scramble the question order AND the answer order for each question.

Most of mine are closed for personal log-in but
