Read the following selections and then write a detailed paragraph in response to the questions beneath. Be sure to use textual evidence to explain your answers.

- b) Compare and contrast the gods in Gilgamesh with God in Genesis

Examine Sir Gawain as a hero. How does he succeed (or fail) in his quest? What does the test reveal about his character?
